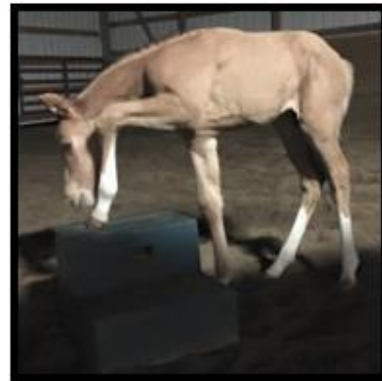


# FUNdamentals of Natural Horsemanship
